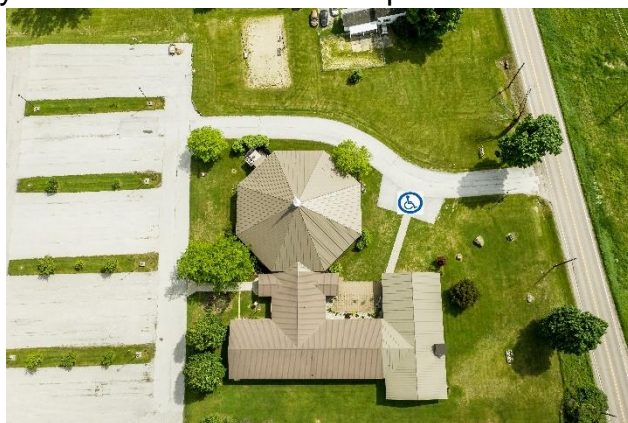




What to Expect for In-Person Sunday Service:

Parking lot –We are reserving the front left parking lot for handicapped parking only. If you need handicap parking, please make your placard visible so the ushers can identify your vehicle and help direct where to park. The side patio doors will be handicap entrance and exit to the building. All others will need to park in the back main parking lot and enter the back main entrance doors. There will be only one exit for everyone which will be the side patio doors.



Doors open for Sunday service at 9:15am, and will close at 9:45am to ensure that if there is extra space and someone does not show up then that person(s) can come in.

Masks will be required to be worn by all people in the building. If you do not have a mask, then the church will provide one for you upon your arrival. If you meet a qualifying exemption from needing to wear a mask then you do not have to, examples of exceptions are children of age 2 and under and those with respiratory conditions such as COPD.

Sanitize Stations will be located around the building for your convenience.

Greeters and ALL Parishioners are asked to not handshake or hug to help with proper social distancing.

Sanctuary Use -Ushers will be seating households together in pews as to help ensure proper social distancing. Some pews will be roped off to help keep distance.

There will be separate entrance and exit doors to and from the sanctuary that will be clearly marked with signs.

The cry room will be available to nursing mothers

The connect corner will be available to parents that need a smaller space for their kids.



Building Use –Hallway bathrooms will be open.

Fellowship hall and education wing will be closed off.

Worship –For the first 4 weeks we will be using videos to lead in worship as the worship team is reassessing how worship will look for the team.

Tithe/Offering Collection –There will be no passing of the offering plates during the offering time, and instead we will be giving an opportunity to give online/ or text to give.

If you plan to write a check, we ask that you please deposit the check in the drop box that is located to the back of the sanctuary walls as you enter or as your exit the space.

Nursery – there will be no nursery services provided for the time being. If a parent has a child who needs a quiet space to go to the nursery will be open for them to go to, but no toys will be available to help keep the space sanitary, and the parent will have to stay with their child the entire time. There will be one COTR volunteer present in the nursery with you and your child if you wish to use the space during service.

Kids Church –There will be no kids church for at least the first 4 weeks of opening. In the meantime, COTR will provide kids with gift bags with wiki sticks, crayons, and activity books that they can use as they join us in service.

Response Time –Being able to pray in response to what God has laid on your heart is very important us and in order to continue to do this in a safe way we will have prayer cards available for you to fill out and can leave them in the drop box at the back of the sanctuary. Your card will be collected by the COTR leadership team and prayed over, and you can also check a box on the back of the card to indicate if you would like someone to follow up with you and pray for you over the phone.

Fellowship Time After Service –We ask that at the end of service not to congregate in the lobby since that will make social distancing very difficult. However, people are welcome to visit out on the patio or in the parking lot.

No Food or Drink in the Building Please!
